## RISK MANAGEMENT

- PRIMARY: to supply policy to enhance harm reduction
- Determined violation to match NIC and other National/International Fraternities
- **SECONDARY:** Understanding the liability & acting in a responsible and respectable way with members & guests

### **PREVENTION**

- PRIMARY: to educate all members to understand the 'why' of harm reduction
- Educating sober monitors and advocating for bystander intervention
- **SECONDARY:** substance-free events and safe driver programs
- Providing knowledge on how to host a safe social effectively

# NORTH AMERICAN INTERFRATERNITY COUNCIL (NIC)

HARM REDUCTION POLICY

The presence of alcohol products above 15% alcohol by volume ("ABV") is prohibited in any Chapter facility, on any [Chapter/organization] premises or at any event, except when served by a licensed and insured third-party vendor.
