Alpha Chi Rho Fraternity is the entity that oversees the Chapters, the Resident Brothers and Graduate Brothers. The National Fraternity operates on resident Brother dues and assessments, graduate Brother dues, and educational grants from the Foundation.

The Educational Foundation exists to support the educational mission of the Fraternity purely through donations by our loyal Brothers and friends of the Fraternity. We offer student loans at low rates, fund educational conclaves and institutes for undergraduates, grant scholarships to resident and graduate Brothers, and support additional leadership initiatives requested by the Chapters and the National Fraternity. Supporting volunteer training through the Crow Coach program, providing Chapter library grants, and funding philanthropic efforts are all part of the Foundation's mission.

When you receive requests for Graduate Fraternity dues, you are giving to the Fraternity to pay for its expenses to support recruitment and Chapter operational functions. These dues are not tax deductible but can be used for anything and everything Fraternity related.

When you give to the Foundation, your donation is fully tax deductible and is used strictly for educational purposes. The more the Foundation can fund, the more the Fraternity can support the men in our Chapters and keep their membership costs manageable. As you will see on pages 30-31, the Fraternity has a list of needs to support our Alpha Chi Rho men. You can be the reason we can make these happen. 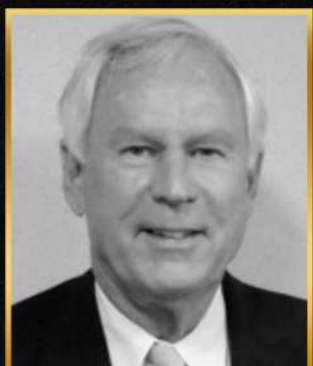

THE BEDFORD ESTATE

Honorable Stanley G. Bedford, Phi Omega, Columbia 1941, was former National President of the Fraternity and Chairman of the Foundation Board. His wife, Ruth G. Bedford, was the Student Loan Manager for nearly six decades.

Collectively, the Bedfords have given over \$300,000 in financial support to the Foundation over the years, including endowing the Stanley G. Bedford scholarship.

In December 2018, Mrs. Ruth G. Bedford officially made a planned gift of her home as a Retained Life Estate to AXPEF, the largest single planned gift in the history of the Foundation.

The home was built in 1885 and was owned by Ruth's relatives in the early 1900s. Ruth and Stan bought the house in the 1960s. Over the years, even beyond Judge Bedford's passing in 1999, the Bedford estate was host to many Foundation and Fraternity meetings and parties annually at their home in Nutley, NJ.

Ruth passed away peacefully on August 19, 2019 at a young 101 years of age. The home now belongs to the Alpha Chi Rho Educational Foundation.

After graduation, Brian became the Vice President of Phi Kappa's Building Association and was a delegate to the University of Illinois' coalition of fraternity alumni boards for several years.

Shane is a founding father of the Phi Pi Chi Chapter at IUP, where he served as the first treasurer and the second president of the Chapter. He has served on the National Staff as a Leadership Consultant/Expansion Director, Director of Chapter Services, and Director of Development. Shane has also served on the National Council as Chaplain.

Shane's career spans 30 years and includes serving as an administrator at various colleges and universities. In addition, he has served as the Executive Director of Theta Phi Alpha, a member of the National Panhellenic Conference, and has served on various national committees and trade associations pertaining to Greek Life.

Shane holds a Doctor of Philosophy in Higher Education Administration degree from Kent State University and has several published papers.

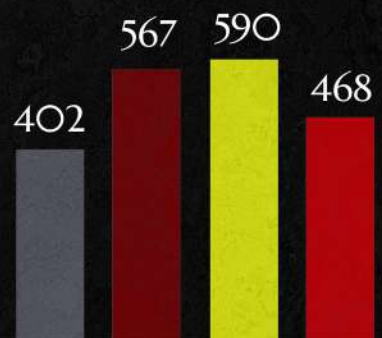

R.B. Stewart, Phi Omicron (Wisconsin 1923), was best known as a "Father of the G.I. Bill", by establishing post-World War II training programs that brought thousands of returning veterans to campuses across the country and fueled national growth and prosperity. He enjoyed a 40-year career at Purdue University as the first Treasurer, where he strategically expanded the university endowment and physical plant that allowed an increase in enrollment by 7000% by his retirement.

Brother Stewart served as the National President from 1940 to 1942 and, later in 1983, made a generous donation allowing Alpha Chi Rho to purchase the first official free-standing Fraternity Headquarters in Neptune, New Jersey. He used his gift as a challenge to every active Chapter to match his gift. 100% of the Chapters gave back.

In 2017, the Foundation named March 31st (RB's birthday) its annual Day of Giving. Since then, over \$32,000 has been raised in just three 24-hour campaigns. Most of the donors are undergraduate men.

AXPEF officially participated in this worldwide nonprofit event in 2016, but 2019 saw the highest dollar amount with \$15,000 in donations. Since our Brothers surpassed the goal of \$10,000 in 24 hours, every resident Chapter was gifted a custom designed garnet and white pennant. \$100+ donors were also given custom designed pennants as a thank you to proudly display in their home or office.

WHAT'S NEXT FOR AXP?

THE FRATERNITY IS FOCUSED ON A MULTITUDE OF THINGS TO IMPROVE THE EXPERIENCE OF OUR RESIDENT AND GRADUATE BROTHERS. THE LAST FIVE YEARS HAVE SEEN THE FRATERNITY GROW EXPONENTIALLY IN EXPANSION PROJECTS, GRADUATE BROTHER INVOLVEMENT, AND NEW SERVICES / RESOURCES; BUT IT HAS ALSO SEEN THE CLOSURE OF LONG-STANDING CHAPTERS AND A SLIGHT DECREASE IN MEMBERSHIP. OVERALL THOUGH, THE FRATERNITY HAS DECIDED TO FOCUS ON FIVE OPERATIONAL ASPECTS: (1) RECRUITMENT EDUCATION AND RESOURCES, (2) EXPANSION, (3) STAFF SUPPORT, (4) CONTINUING LIFE SKILLS EDUCATION, AND (5) MEANINGFUL COMMUNITY SERVICE.

1 All Chapters and Colonies need to learn how to recruit in the twenty-first century. The current student entering college is not the same as the one that entered in 2015. The tactics that our Chapters have relied on over the past ten or fifteen years have become outdated. The Fraternity has continued to offer free regional Growth Summits to all resident members and is utilizing experts to train our men, staff, advisors, and Crow Coaches. Alpha Chi Rho Brothers, on any level of membership, will be on the cutting edge of growing their Chapters / Colonies.



Additionally, the Fraternity has a Crow Coach program which has been growing in the past year. The purpose of the Crow Coach is to assist the Chapter with recruitment and financial management; however, many of our Coaches become general Chapter advisors and mentors for our Brothers.

2 Since 2016, the Fraternity has been overseeing and completing multiple expansion projects. Some of these include campuses that have a dormant Chapter; others have not experienced Alpha Chi Rho. Regardless, the Fraternity provides a live-in staff member for each expansion effort to begin the expansion process, cultivate the members, and build a foundation for a high-performing Chapter. Having a live-in staff member takes away from the resources that the Fraternity can offer to other Chapters, so the Fraternity seeks to hire additional staff and train alumni volunteers to assist in the expansion process. Optimally, the staff, students, and volunteers work together to achieve the Institution / Re-Institution of the Chapter within eighteen months.



3 The National staff has always been a resource to our resident and graduate Brothers. The staff is responsible for the day-to-day upkeep of the Fraternity, including training and educating resident Chapters on operations, helping Graduate Brothers create graduate Chapters and bolstering their support of their resident Chapter, assisting Building / Property Associations with their bookkeeping and leasing, and being the main contact for members at the National Office. The Fraternity is looking to grow the staff through the hiring of a summer intern, a year-round intern, and an additional Leadership Consultant which would allow the Fraternity to better assist the membership.



4 The Fraternity has always taken a stand against hazing and illegal practices. In the last five years, the Fraternity has formed a partnership with No2Hazing, a third-party company that specializes in educating Greek members about hazing and bystander intervention. All new members and officers are required to take courses on both hazing and bystander intervention. In 2019, the Fraternity evolved the program by launching a specific learning management system (LMS) called CultivatingU. CultivatingU is a revolutionary way to educate our resident and graduate members by teaching them about multiple topics such as diversity and inclusion, sexual misconduct and prevention, risk management, accountability, operations, and academic success. The Fraternity is looking to grow our catalog of courses to better assist our resident members and create specific resources for all Chapter advisors, volunteers, and Crow Coaches.



5 Alpha Chi Rho's Revered Founders were men of service. That value has been instilled since our Founding, and the Fraternity has always looked for ways that our members can do meaningful service in both their local communities and greater society. The Fraternity has recently volunteered with the St. Bernard's Project (SBP) - a non-profit dedicated to helping people return to their homes after natural disasters such as hurricanes or earthquakes. Through SBP, the Fraternity is looking to provide opportunities to serve throughout the year and sponsor members to attend an alternative spring break - a weeklong trip to somewhere in the United States or Caribbean to serve the local community ravaged by a natural disaster. These programs would allow more members to experience personal growth through commitment to others and would separate Alpha Chi Rho from other national fraternities.

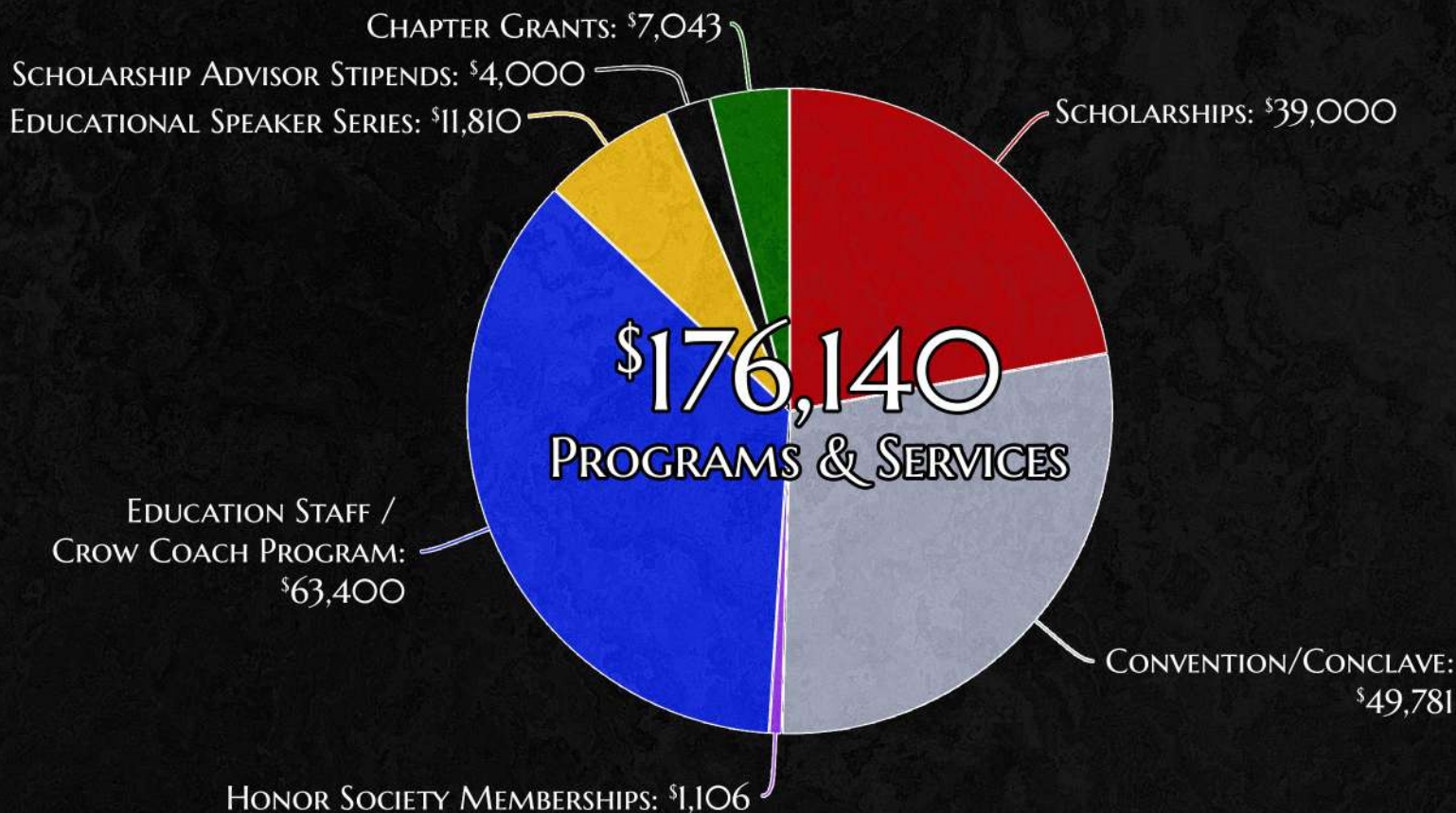

We may have met at Convention, talked on the phone, exchanged emails, had dinner in your hometown or simply connected on social media. Whatever interaction we have had, I sense the same love and passion for Alpha Chi Rho. I am proud to know you and grateful for your faith in the future of AXP Cultivating Men of Word and Deed.

Since 1950, when the Foundation was established, we have been fortunate that many of our Brothers had estate plans which include AXPEF as a beneficiary in some way. We have been recipients of charitable gift trusts, scholarship endowments, and unrestricted leadership gifts thanks to those who have gone before us. Their planned gifts have already been realized. So, what guarantees do we have for 2020 and beyond?

In this 125th anniversary year of the Fraternity and the 70th year of the Foundation, we asked Brothers like you, how we can better assist you in creating a legacy of lasting impact without disinheriting your loved ones. We're proud to introduce three gift opportunities that do just that.

- 1 The Charitable Gift Annuity (CGA)** provides tax benefits and income for you or a loved one for life. CGAs offer the security of fixed payments to one or two annuitants, guaranteed by the Foundation.
- 2 The Charitable Remainder Trust (CRT)** allows you to make a gift through your will or trust, save money for the future, take care of your loved ones, and leave the remainder to the Foundation. CRTs provide variable payments to beneficiaries but can offer a greater return with income for a lifetime, a term of years, or a combination of the two.
- 3 A Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD)** is a distribution from an IRA made directly to an eligible charity, bypassing the owner of the account. Owners of individual retirement accounts who are at least age 72 can contribute some or all of their IRAs to charity. Required Minimum Distributions from your IRAs in the form of QCDs are not taxable on your Federal Income Tax return.
