WHAT DO YOU DO WITH MY MONEY?

Donors often have two questions: Do you really need my money? What do you do with it?

We use your money to carry out the Foundation's Mission, especially cultivating academic excellence and leadership development through scholarships and loans, grants to Chapters and the National Fraternity, and services available to all Brothers, all in support of their growth and maturity:



Every year, we award seven scholarships to undergraduate Brothers to support the cost of their academic growth, and four to graduate Brothers seeking advanced education, largely from restricted donations.



We provide low-interest loans to Brothers needing funds. Repayment does not begin until after graduation.



We support the Fraternity's InDeed Institute, held each non-Convention year to educate the Fraternity's future leaders in terms of Character, Honor, and Integrity and the meaning of our Landmarks.



Each year, we support the travel expenses of Resident Brothers attending the Northeast Greek Leadership Association's annual Leadership Conference and contribute support for its educational speakers.



We offer Educational Grants to Chapters that dedicate a portion of their House to educational purposes, supported by major donations provided specifically for each grant.



We also provide grants to Chapters that support the growth of their libraries, help pay for educational speakers, reimburse expenses incurred in carrying out their own charitable activities, cover the cost of induction into campus honor societies, and pay for PPE supplies such as masks and sanitizers.



We encourage every Resident Chapter to find a Scholarship Advisor by reimbursing the Advisor for part of their time and giving the Chapter a matching grant.



We annually award the National Fraternity funds to meet its programs and services that support our mission, including anti-hazing programs and supporting educational activities for Colonies and new Chapters.

LONG RANGE PLAN FOR FOUNDATION COMES TOGETHER.



Executive Summary:

The Next Five Years, 2022-2026 is the Alpha Chi Rho Educational Foundation's long-range plan to implement the Mission Statement it adopted in 2019 while maintaining the programs and services it now offers to the Brothers of Alpha Chi Rho, the National Fraternity, and other parties.

The plan contemplates actions in five areas:

- Promoting Academic Excellence and Leadership
- Educational Sponsorships
- Communication
- Infrastructure Resources
- Finances

Across them, it sets goals to which the Foundation aspires to progress with 20 specific objectives and strategies the Foundation intends to achieve over the plan's five-year period.

In the area of Promoting Academic Excellence and Leadership, the objectives include creation of a liaison program to assist the Fraternity's Chapters to develop their members' academic growth, work with the Fraternity to create a career network and platform of skills-based training resources, and support ways in which recent Graduate Brothers can serve as good role models for undergraduate Brothers.

In the area of Educational Sponsorships, the objectives include both developing new educational sponsorships to meet identified needs and growing the Foundation's assets to increase the financial support for them. The Foundation also will provide input on the educational programs of the National Fraternity that it supports and regularly evaluate their effectiveness.

To enhance its Communication with undergraduate and Graduate Brothers and other interested parties, it will develop new communication vehicles and adopt new communication platforms to meet the needs of individual Brothers, the Fraternity's Chapters, and other parties.

In the area of Infrastructure Resources over the five-year period, the Foundation will both increase its full-time staff to support its new initiatives and expand its pool of Brothers and other volunteers to support the staff. The Foundation plans to assess and improve its productivity and to increase participation of volunteers.

Finally, in Finances, the Foundation will seek to grow its assets from \$3.5 million today to \$5 million by 2026 while operating in a fiscally responsible manner.

The plan's appendix includes detailed tactical plans to use in achieving the objectives.

THE MAN WITH A PLAN

AN INTERVIEW WITH BYRON P. CONNELL, PHI PHI 1963

Sitting back in his chair on the other end of a video call, Byron Connell is recounting his journey as a young college student at the University of Pennsylvania. Initiated on May 17, 1960, he joined the Phi Phi Chapter, thanks to the one and only Curly Walden.

Byron recalls: *"I am a Crow because of Curly Walden. In my freshman year, 'rush' consisted of social events at fraternity houses. I had gone to several, including at AXP, and decided not to join any fraternity. Curly came to campus to help Phi Phi's rush and had the names of a few men that he wanted to talk with, including me. He came to my dorm room one evening, when I was reading, knocked on my door, introduced himself as Wilbur Walden, National Secretary of Alpha Chi Rho, and asked if he could talk with me about the Fraternity. He stressed the Fraternity's values and invited me to come back to the House to meet some of the Brothers. He was very persuasive."*

Upon meeting the other two students who would be part of my Postulant class, Byron and his future Brothers said yes. At Phi Phi as an undergraduate, Byron served as Pledge Master (Postulant Educator in today's terms), Treasurer, and Ritual Officer.

After graduating from Penn with a Bachelor of Arts in History, Byron went on to complete a Master of Arts degree in Russian History from the State University of New York at Albany. He taught for six years and then took a position with the New York State Education Department's Office of Higher Education, where he carried out quality assurance and long-range planning for New York's public and nonpublic higher education portion of The University of the State of New York for 42 years.

Byron's love for Alpha Chi Rho has been a constant in throughout his life. At the Phi Phi Club (their version of a Graduate Chapter), Byron has served as a member of the Board of Directors for several years. His introduction to the Foundation was not until after he graduated from Penn. *"I guess I was vaguely aware of the Foundation as an undergraduate. I really did not know much about it until the Foundation began to solicit me for donations. I tried to make small gifts, but marriage and family soon came first. Once we were more settled, I resumed making contributions. I still was not very knowledgeable about what the Foundation actually did until several years later."*

In 1990, Jim Spencer ("Spence"), who was National Secretary at the time, invited Byron to become a Trustee. *"I was making regular donations in amounts that, to me at the time, were substantial, but probably weren't that substantial from the Foundation's perspective. Spence had spoken with me several times to thank me for my gifts and to let me know what the Foundation was doing, so I guess my name was out there."*

After talking it over with his wife, Tina, Byron agreed to come to Convention (at a hotel in Vermont that year), where the Board voted him in until the next Annual Meeting, where he would have to seek election. He has been a Trustee ever since. That was over 20 years ago.

"My work related to higher education and my experience working with groups and participating in meetings significantly helped me to function as a Trustee," Byron explains. *"It's a good way to continue to participate in the work of the Fraternity. AXPEF is almost totally run by volunteers; right now, we have one paid staff member. Involvement runs from assisting with specific projects or activities to serving as officers. Our style is completely collegial and some of our standing committees are chaired by volunteers"*

other than Trustees.”

According to Byron, the Foundation’s programs and services remind undergraduates that there is more to AXP than just their Chapter – there is a Brotherhood of men across the world who strive to live by the Landmarks and try, each in his own way, to improve society. More concretely, of course, AXPEF scholarships and loans for individual Brothers and grants for Chapters help them achieve their own goals. Those programs reinforce the ideals of our Brotherhood.

Byron was elected as Chairman of the Board in 2019, just before the 125th anniversary of the Fraternity. Under his leadership, the Foundation adopted a new statement of its mission in 2020:

The Alpha Chi Rho Educational Foundation cultivates academic excellence and leadership development through financial assistance and program support for the educational pursuits and initiatives of the Brothers, Chapters, the National Council of the Fraternity of Alpha Chi Rho, and other students. The Foundation fosters lifetime commitment to personal enrichment and community service by members of Alpha Chi Rho as Men of Word and Deed.

To ensure the Foundation carries out this mission effectively, the Board adopted a long-range plan to guide their activities between now and 2026. It calls for action in five areas:

- Promoting Academic Excellence and Leadership
- Educational Sponsorships
- Communication
- Infrastructure Resources
- Finances

Across these areas, goals have been set to which AXPEF intends to progress, with 20 specific objectives and strategies to achieve over the five-year period. “Carrying out those actions, and related developments, is where the Foundation will focus its efforts. To do so, I predict the Foundation will add new programs and services while maintain the current programs and services that have served the Brotherhood well over the last several decades,” Byron explains.

Byron has been a man with a plan ever since that knock on the door by Curly Walden. A storied life influenced by his decision to join the Brotherhood, Byron has many interests including reading science fiction and fantasy. He is an active amateur practitioner of the art of costuming and frequently helps run costume conferences. The International Costumers’ Guild honored him with its Lifetime Achievement Award in 1996. Subsequently, he served three terms as the Guild’s president. Byron lives with his wife, Christine (“Tina”), in Albany, NY, with a cat and too many books. They have one adult child.

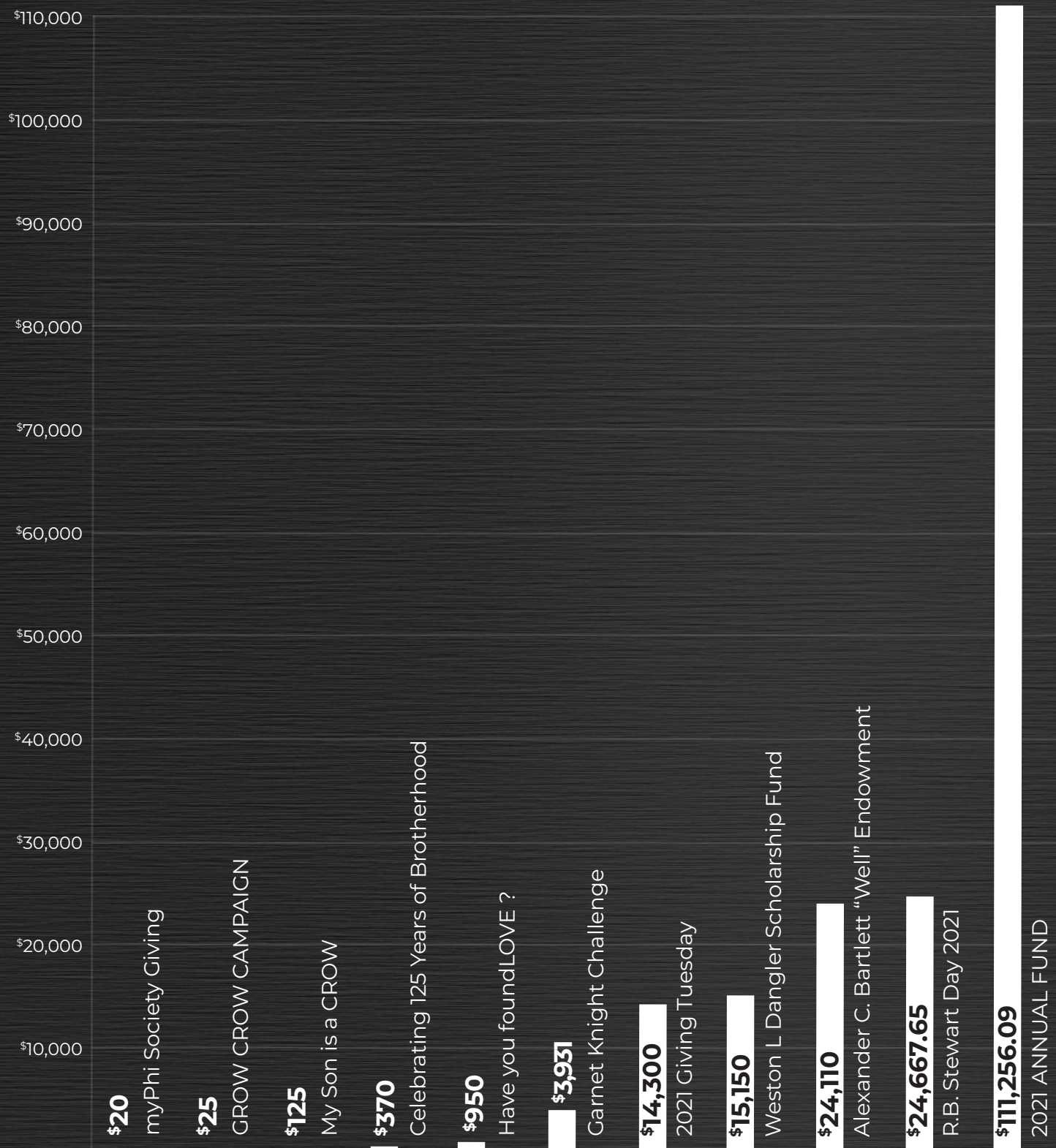

In October, our inaugural golf tournament and spaghetti dinner kicked off with help and leadership from Holly Bickle (Alex’s mother) which took the fund to even higher limits. The tournament sold out with over 30 golfing teams competing in a 4-person scramble. There were even putting, longest drive, and hole-in-one contests. At night the spaghetti dinner was packed full of laughs, tears, and stories commemorating Alex’s life. It also gave an opportunity to present the purpose of the Endowment to the community. Over 150 people packed the pavilion, where more than 100 prizes and raffles were given out including a huge flat screen tv and stainless steel grill. As the night came to an end, the men of the Lock Haven Chapter presented Holly with sweetheart letters from the Fraternity. Overall, it was a fantastic night and celebration with friends, family, and Brothers. Last year was a success and we are looking forward to an even bigger one this year.

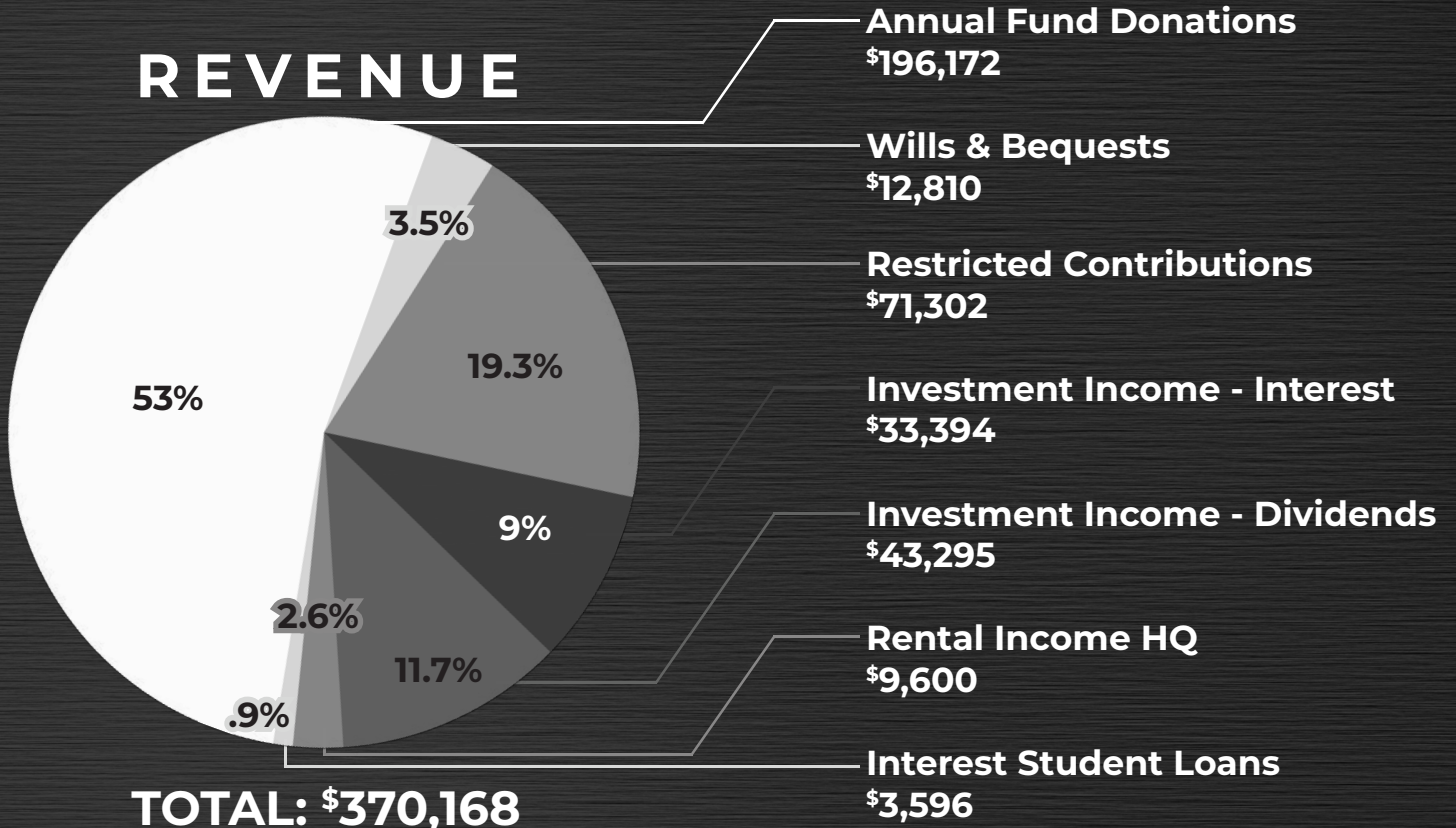

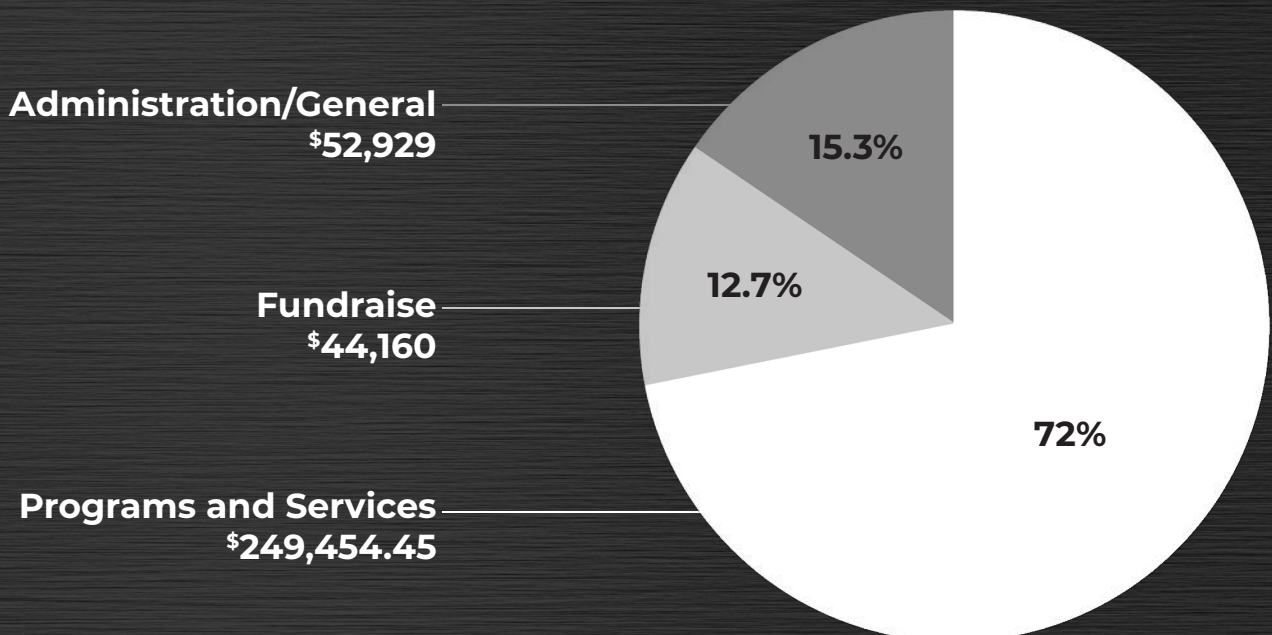
FUND ALLOCATION

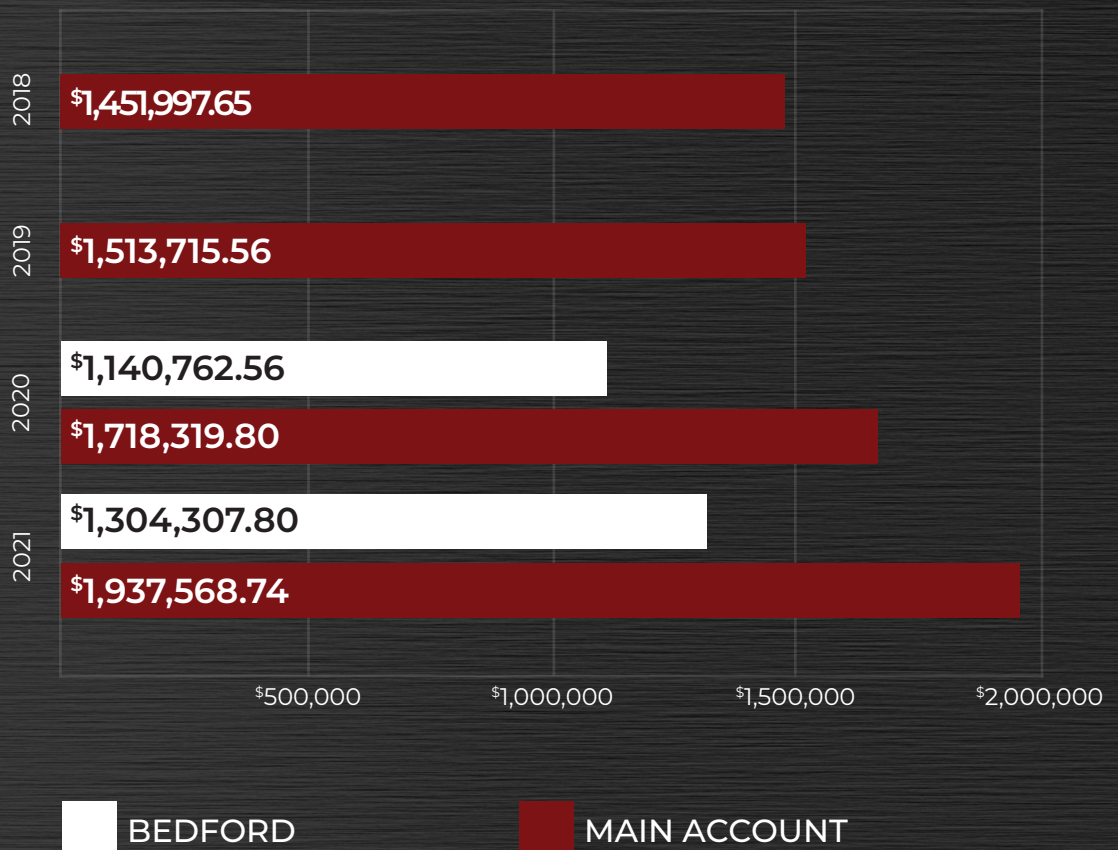

The Foundation's asset allocation places priority on preserving endowment corpus by conservatively investing in a mix of equity and debt index funds to produce investment returns at a rate exceeding inflation. The Investment Committee of the Foundation is responsible for the management of all endowed funds of the Alpha Chi Rho Educational Foundation. These funds include the Main endowment and the Bedford endowment, which both support the educational programming of the Fraternity, as well as the numerous scholarships designated to support the ongoing education of our active members and alumni pursuing undergraduate and graduate degrees that you find throughout this Annual Report. The primary goal of AXPEF's portfolios is growth of principal over time through investment earnings and appreciation to expand our educational activities.
