

PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT

Recruitment - Through our partnership with Phired Up, all members are able to complete a certification course on making connections with other students both virtually and in-person.

"CultivatingU" - On our unique learning platform, all members are able to complete courses on Accountability, Sexual Assault and Prevention, Time Management, Academic Success, and Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion.

Hazing Prevention - All Alpha Chi Rho new members are required to complete No2Hazing before the mid-way point of new member education. All officers are also required to complete the course every fall.

National Community Service Partners - With Alpha Chi Rho's national partnership with Habitat for Humanity and the JED Foundation, and the Gift of Life Marrow Registry, all members have the ability to make an impact in their local communities.
