

## Crow bowl (Football) Guidelines and Application Deadline August 31<sup>st</sup>

Crow bowl East (Football) is a flag football tournament that is hosted by local Chapters of Alpha Chi Rho. The event is held in October or November on a weekend when most of our Colonies/Chapters do not have their own Homecomings or other major campus events.

Each Colony and Chapter is encouraged to apply. The national staff will review all of the applications and will use certain factors to decide who will host the event. These factors include but are not limited to: Colony/Chapter location, requirements met in application and financial situation of Colony/Chapter. Remember to think about food, entertainment, shirts, trophies, etc.

Application requirements:

- Contact information for person handling and submitting the application. Please include name, address, phone number, and email address.
- Flag Football Rules: The rules for the tournament should be the same rules that are played at your institution's intramural flag football games. If your institution does not have flag football intramural games, then speak to an athletic director at your campus to obtain a copy. These rules need to be in the application and used at Crow bowl.
- Referees: Referees cannot be members of your Colony or Chapter. They need to be official referees. For example, if your institution has intramural sports, hire those referees to referee the games.
- Plan on having some type of events going on during the games so Brothers are not just standing around in between games.
- Please prepare a budget which will contain what the event costs per player, expenses, food, etc.
- Make sure you have permission from your institution, some type of EMS or medical staff on hand, and adequate parking for this event.
- It is optional to plan an event after the games are completed. If you do, please include details.
- Sample announcement that the National Headquarters will send out to Colonies and Chapters. (Please create in Microsoft Word Format.)
- Schedule of the day, including trophy ceremony and singing of Amici.
